All Smith's current exhibition at the Mark Moore Gallery, "We Find Ways' showcase a stunning selection of painting from emerging talent All Smith. Her expressive compositions include sweths of pure, beautifully mixed vibrant colors conversing with finear detail and architectural yet organic structures, that are at once playful yet precarious. Referencing the formstifet ploys of abstract expressionism, her works attempt to give the historical trope new relevance.

Particularly stunning are unexpected combinations, such as in Geek Love, 'a neon controlled chaos flaunting hot pink holding court with royal purple and small shots of electric blue. The quality of the paint tasel' is raw, seductive and viscoral, seemingly applied in an off-the-outly, intuitive fashion. Smith pairs sensuous passages of butter-cream brushstrokes with less defacite, rough instances of bold, impasto color. By shving no fixed resolution in mind, her paintings adopt a spontaneous quality, as if recording her inner thought process, whime, or. Like neurological maps, the surfaces of her canvasses document her evident love for the act of painting itself. Lesie Mankle notes, "[All Smith's] canny knack for whimey permits a defacte balance to exist between purely decorative gestures and those of grotesque vulgarity."

Al Smith received her MFA from California State University, Long Beach, CA in 2003. In this past year alone she has had solo shows in Los Angeles, Boston and Houston as well as exhibiting her work in group shows in New York, Germany and Austria among others. She was recently included in Christopher Knight's article '45 Painters Under 455' in the Los Angeles Time. This will be her second solo exhibition at the Mark Moore Gallery. All Smith lives and works in Long Beach, CA.
